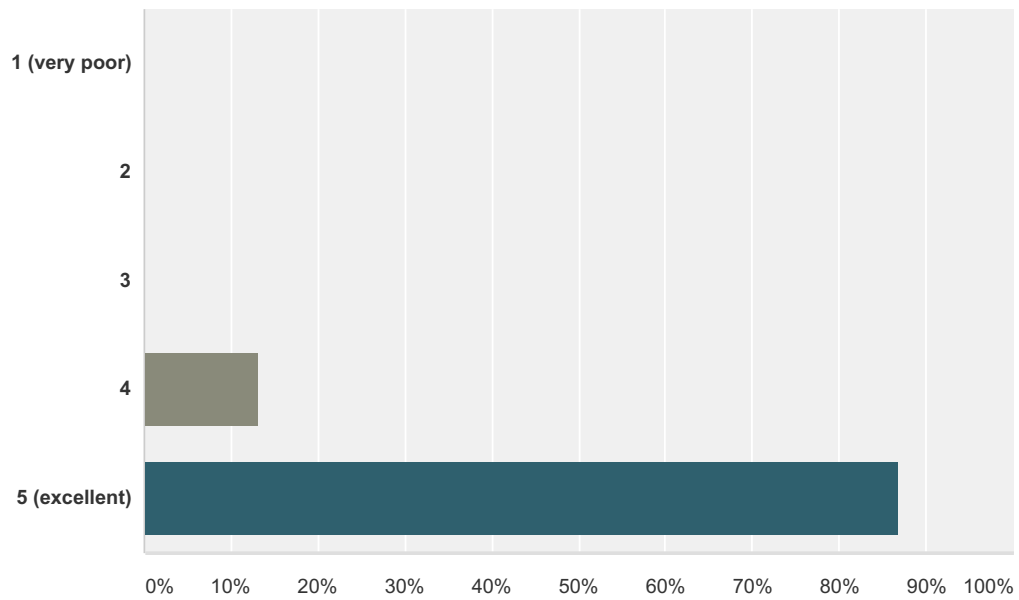


Q86 Overall, how would you rate the quality of the childcare provided by the program?

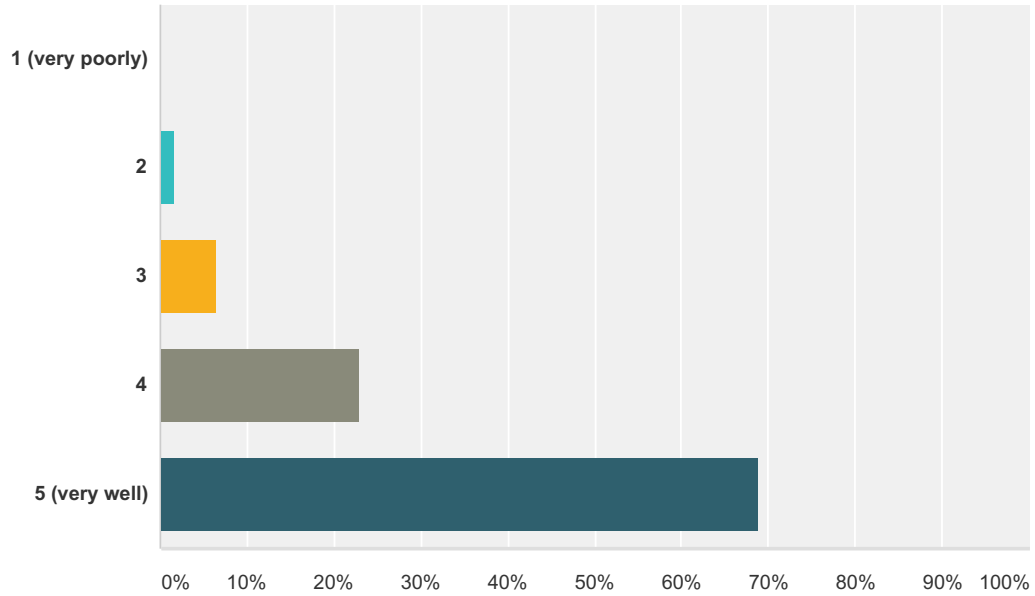

Q87 How well do you feel the program administrators communicate information to parents?

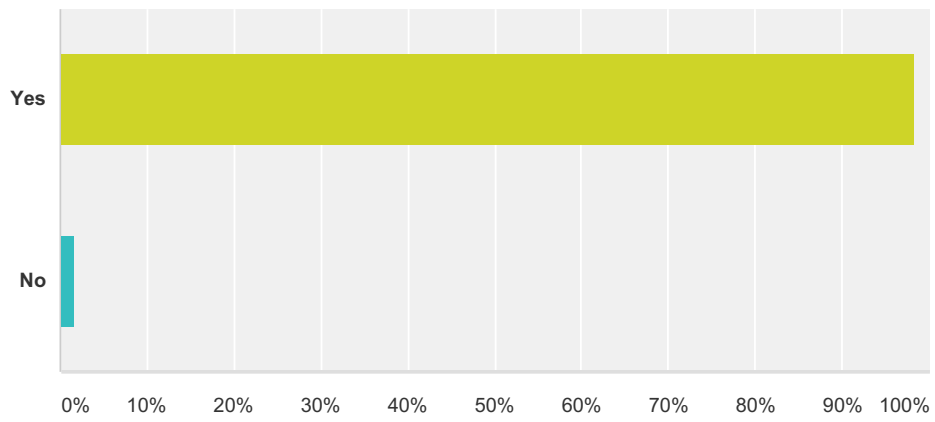

Q88 Do you read our monthly Newsletter distributed via email?

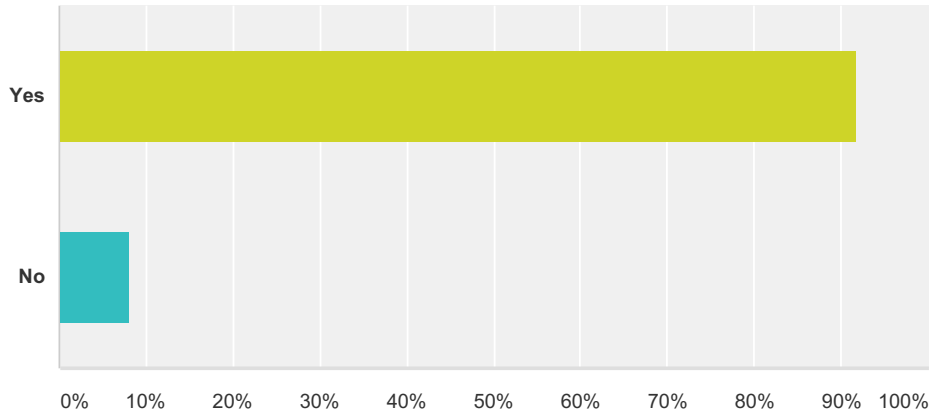

Q89 Have you visited our website?

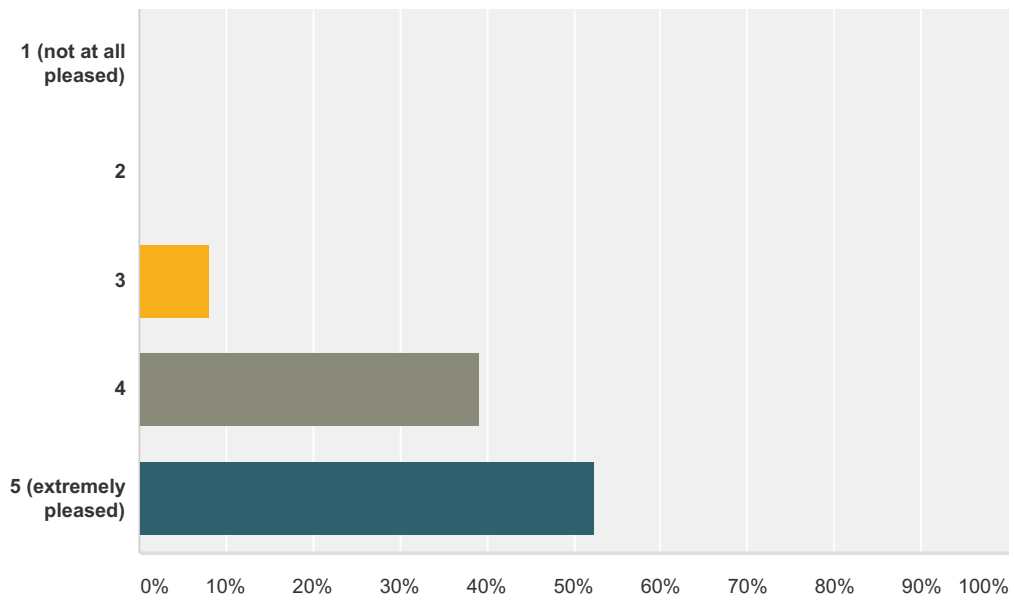

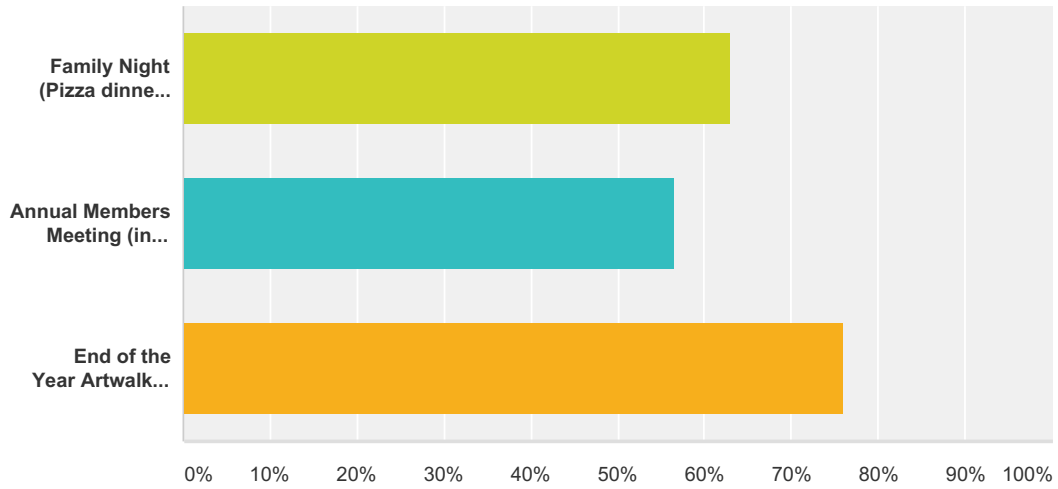

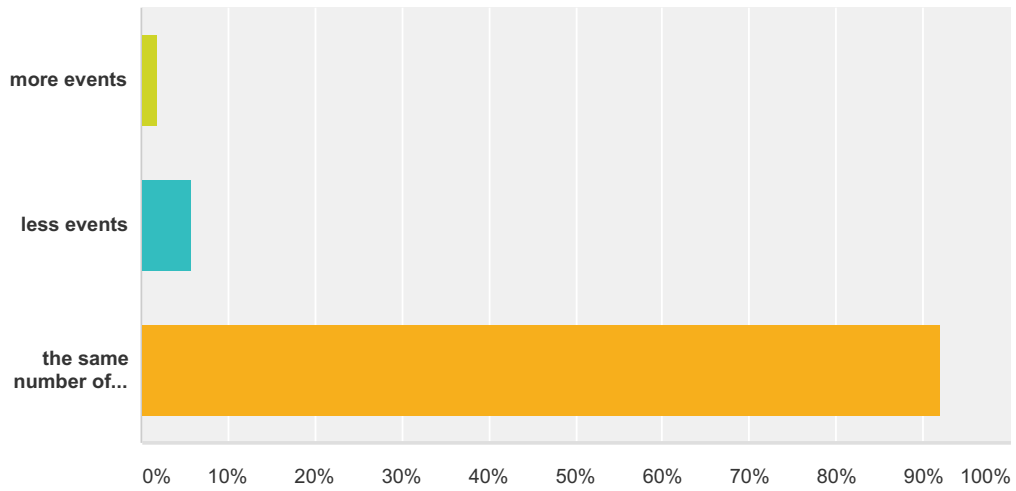

Please select one below.**

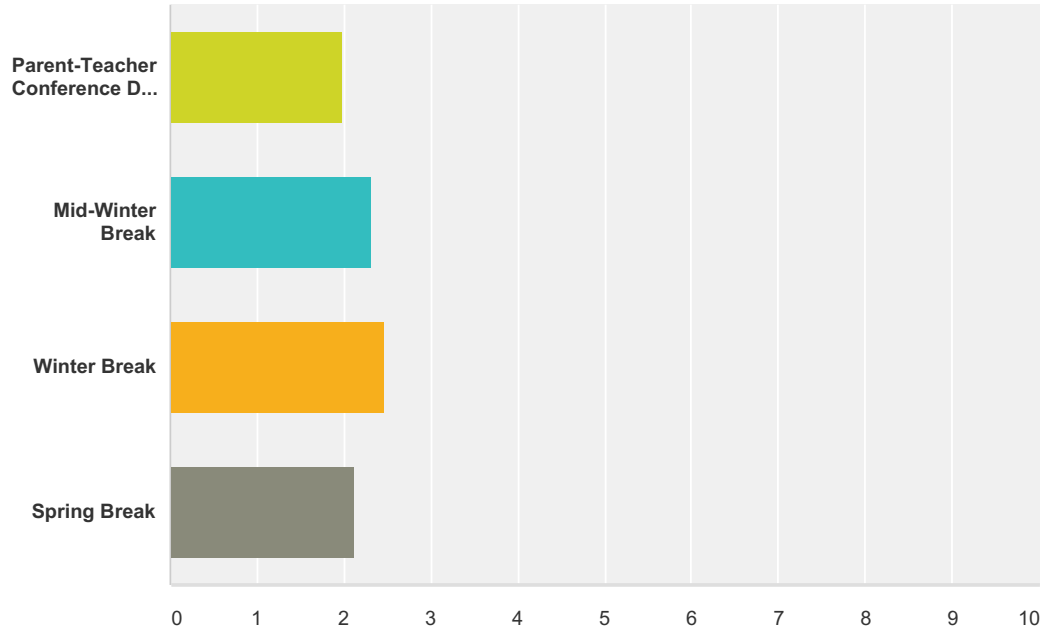

Q96 Does your child attend LSA during school Breaks? If so, please indicate which breaks:

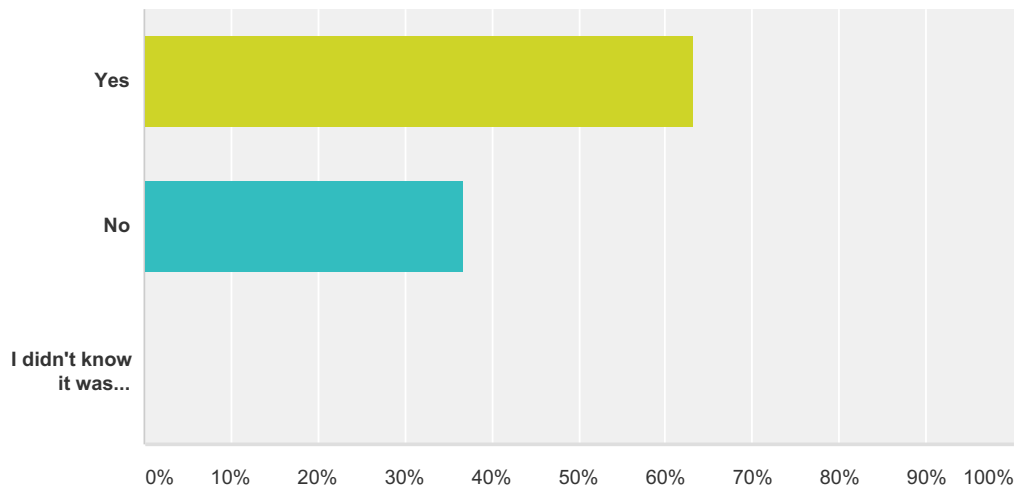
